SHORT BIO

The Honourable Yonah Martin is a Conservative Senator from British Columbia, appointed by The Right Hon. Stephen Harper in 2009. She is the first Canadian of Korean descent to serve in the Senate of Canada and the first Korean-Canadian parliamentarian in Canadian history.


She is currently the Deputy Leader of the Opposition in the Senate (since November 2015); and previously served as the Deputy Leader of the Government (2013–2015); and as Deputy Whip of the Government (2011–2013). Her notable achievements in the Senate include the enactment of her Senate Public Bill (Korean War Veterans Day Act) and adoption of her motion to recognize June as Deaf-blind Awareness Month (June 2013); the successful campaign to add Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) and Acupuncturists to the schedule of health professionals for GST/HST exemption (April 2014); and as Co-Chair of Canada Korea Interparliamentary Friendship Group (CKIFG), her involvement in the multi-year process to negotiate and eventually implement the historic Canada Korea Free Trade Agreement (January 2015).

SHORT BIO

Gene Moo Lee (이진무) is an Assistant Professor of Information Systems at the Sauder School of Business, University of British Columbia. He received a Ph.D. in Computer Science from the University of Texas at Austin in 2015. His research program is to advance business analytics using AI approaches with three objectives: (1) to develop novel analytics methods using AI (machine learning, computer vision, NLP); (2) to use the analytics framework to derive theoretical insights from data-intensive platforms (e.g., social media, mobile app market, e-commerce, video advertising, service robots); and (3) to understand and mitigate IT and analytics-related risks (e.g., cybersecurity, misinformation). He is a member of the UBC AI Research Centre (CAIDA). He has extensive industry experiences at Samsung, AT&T, Intel, and Goldman Sachs, has conducted collaboration projects with various tech firms (e.g., Yahoo, IGAWorks, SMR, KISTI, KIRI), and holds 11 patents in mobile technology.
