### Message From Our Volunteers!



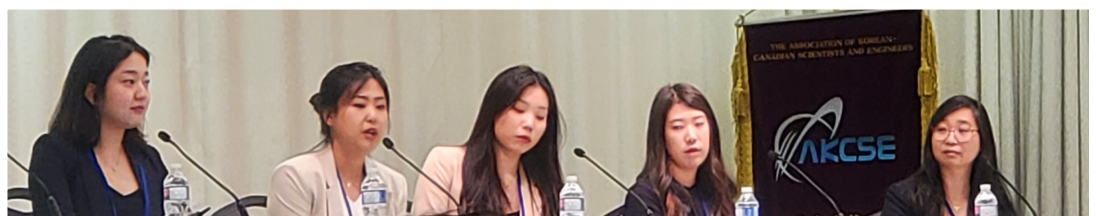

## YGP Corner

The CKC 2022 YGP Program took place during CKC, from July 4–8, 2022. With five primary and two ancillary sessions, the CKC 2022 YGP Program was structured with a core purpose of diminishing the divide between industry and academic professions. The program involved sessions dedicated to showcasing the diverse occupations and their respective projects within YGP, sharing experiences and lessons learnt at the workplace as young professionals, and presenting creative, innovative ideas on promoting sustainability within the university environment.

In total, 14 invited speakers attended the CKC 2022 YGP Program, sharing their experiences through engaging presentations on topics such as managing mental health as a student in STEM, providing constructive criticism, agile frameworks for project management, and personal finances. Other presentations also involved an introduction to various academic and industry projects in the fields of agricultural engineering, biomedical engineering, industrial engineering, mechanical engineering, and full stack development.

Chapter Representatives (the Chapter President or proxy) from 19 YG/YP chapters from across Canada also attended the YGP program this year, participating in the YGP Leadership Workshop, where they were provided an opportunity to learn about leadership skills useful for running an AKCSE YG/YP chapter and speak to other Chapter Representatives on common issues. Chapter Representatives were also granted an opportunity to ask questions regarding operations to the AKCSE President, President Il Yong Kim, and engage in small-group discussions with the HQ YGP Committee Director, Professor Hyun-Joong Chung.

The rest of the CKC 2022 YGP Program were focused primarily on establishing a network among peers, as well as other invited guests, such as the Ambassador of the Republic of Korea to Canada, Keung Ryong Chang, and the President of KEIT, Yang-ho Jung. With our emphasis on community-building, the CKC 2022 YGP Socials were a huge success, gathering YGP members partaking in various roles in the conference through the YGP Happy Hour and YGP + Volunteer Networking Sessions.

## CKC2022 설문조사 - 김천일 디렉터

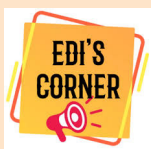

#### 평등, 다양성 및 포용성

**Glass Ceiling** – a qualified person wishing to advance within the hierarchy of his/her organization is stopped at a lower level due to a discrimination most often based on sexism or racism

**Bamboo Ceiling** – processes and barriers that serve to exclude Asians and Asian-Americans from executive positions on the basis of subjective factors such as "lack of leadership potential"
