Senator's Message



Upcoming 44th Session


Canadians elected another minority Liberal Government in the recent fall election. Canada's Conservatives will continue to hold the government to account as Her Majesty's Loyal Official Opposition in the upcoming new session. Senator Martin was in the National Capital this past month to attend Senate Caucus and National Caucus, in preparation for the 44th Parliament under the leadership of the Honourable Erin O'Toole. The Senate caucus re-acclaimed Senator Martin as Deputy Leader and re-elected Senator Plett as Leader and Senator Poirier as Caucus Chair. She also met with Her Excellency Svetlana Stoycheva-Etropoliski, Ambassador of Bulgaria; and His Excellency Keung Ryong Chang, Ambassador of the Republic of Korea in Ottawa, for two insightful and productive discussions about diplomatic and bilateral relations. The National Korean War Commemorative Committee meeting was also held via Zoom with representatives from KWCC across Canada to discuss and prepare for the various commemorative ceremonies and events to support and honour our veterans during Veterans Week, Turn Toward Busan and Remembrance Day.

October was a productive month for the 2021 Virtual Parliamentary Internship Program.
